TEXAS CITRUS FIESTA RULES

******Notice to Parade Participants******

In order to comply with the City fire codes and our rules and regulations, you must adhere to these rules.

1. Health permits are required, for food vendors, from the City of Mission, however, state health permits are valid. Applications are available from the Texas Citrus Fiesta office, or contact the City of Mission Health Department for more information: 580-8697.
2. No open flames (no Barbeque pits or electrical cords) near gas pumps or close to the selling area. They must be at least 50 feet away from pumps.
3. All alleys must stay clear.
4. Fire hydrants must be kept clear; set-ups must be at least 15 feet away.
5. All food booths must provide their own fire extinguishers. (You must have one if any electrical appliances, light fixtures, gas grill, charcoal pit or generator are part of your set-up) **All set-ups will be inspected by the fire marshal.s office. You must comply with all rules or you will be asked to leave with no entry refund.**
6. City sidewalks must be kept clear at all times.
7. You must keep your area clean during and at the end of the event. Proper disposal of your waste is required. We do not provide trash bags for you. Do not empty used oil on the grounds or in drains. Place them in a container and dispose of them properly. This is an outdoor event . remember to weigh your paper items down or keep them in a covered container.
8. There is to be **NO** religious or political advertising or propaganda distributed from your booth.
9. No alcoholic beverages are allowed unless you are part of the vaquero competition.
10. A hand sanitizing station is required at all booths that are serving food. (i.e. a water-jug with spout and a catch bucket for the dirty water.)
15. Be sure to include phone numbers, the Parade Committee will be contacting vendors on the evening of the eighteenth of January to verify what products you are permitted to sell. (All decisions are final, and are not up for debate!)
